The Stan Winvick Scholarship for Human Resource Management

The Advanced Micro Device Corporation sponsors an annual scholarship for one outstanding student in Human Resource Management at San Jose State University. The amount of the award varies based on financial markets and interest rates but has typically been in the \$3-5,000 range. The recipient is encouraged to consider seeking an internship or other position with AMD that may be arranged depending on availability, mutual interest, and relevant qualifications. However, willingness to do so or to accept a position if offered is not required in order to apply.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. GPA in HR concentration and overall upper division GPA in O&M courses
2. Interest in HRM and in pursuing an HR career.
3. Work and professional experience in HR or related field(s) [e.g., I-O Psychology]
4. Extra-curricular activities
5. Overall qualifications, merit, and viability
6. Particular skills and knowledge in research, computers, or communication technology
7. Interest in working/availability to work at AMD if position offered
